## HEALTH SERVICES RESEARCH POLICY & ADMINISTRATION MINOR

The Health Services Research Policy & Administration minor is available to students who are interested in the social, political, and economic forces that affect the operations, financing, and delivery of health care. This minor offers a high degree of flexibility in course selection, which can be tailored to individual interests and goals of the student. There are 6 required credits for Masters students. Doctoral students will select electives in consultation with advisor and Director of Graduate Studies to complete the 12 credit minimum. All minor coursework must be taken A – F. Graduate credits can be applied toward either the major or the minor/other requirement, but not both.
