

SEXUAL HEALTH MINOR

The Sexual Health Minor is designed for students who want to specialize in sex, sexuality, reproductive health, and sexual health. By taking public health courses tailored specifically to address sexual health, students are better able to enter the professional world with the confidence and skills needed to handle complex questions and issues related to sexual and reproductive health. There are 6 required credits for Masters students. Doctoral students will select electives in consultation with advisor and Director of Graduate Studies to complete the 12 credit minimum. All required minor coursework must be taken A – F and achieve a grade of B- or above. Elective courses can be taken S/N or A/F. If taken as A/F, students must achieve a B- or above. Graduate credits can be applied toward either the major or the minor/other requirement, but not both.
